

Everyone has the right to vote!

New Brunswick is preparing for a provincial election on September 14, 2020. Elections NB will send your voter information card in the mail, which contains some important information:

- Advance polling station location
- Election day polling station location
- Local returning office location and contact information



To make voting as accessible and convenient as possible, Elections NB offers several different ways to cast your vote:

In person on Election Day

- Voting between 10:00am and 8:00pm on September 14, 2020

In person at an Advance Poll

- Voting between 10:00am and 8:00pm on September 5, 2020 and September 8, 2020

In person at a Returning Office

- Find more information about your Returning Office at www.electionsnb.ca

By mail

- Download and complete the [Application for a Special Ballot](#) from the Elections NB website
- Send your Application for a Special Ballot to your Returning Office by fax or email
- Receive your Special Ballot Mail-In Voting Kit in the mail
- Mark your Special Ballot and send it back to your Returning Office

In person at home

- Contact your Returning Office and ask for special voting officers to visit your home

In person at a nursing home or special care home

- An Additional Poll may be arranged at the centre

If you need help to mark your ballot, a friend or election officer can assist you.

Every Canadian adult has the right to vote in an election. Options such as voting at home or by mail can make it more accessible to exercise this right for anyone unable to attend a polling station in person.
