Living Free From Poverty in Inclusive Communities



- A new disability income support program with fair and accessible eligibility criteria and application processes, higher monthly benefits and enhanced incentives and supports for employment



- A Home First policy to support adults with a disability to live in their own home



- Expand the Portable Rent Subsidy Program to provide an additional 60 subsidies per year for people with a disability over the next three years



- Regional transportation plans developed with a clear disability lens
